The American Cancer Society hosted its most successful Celestial Gala,

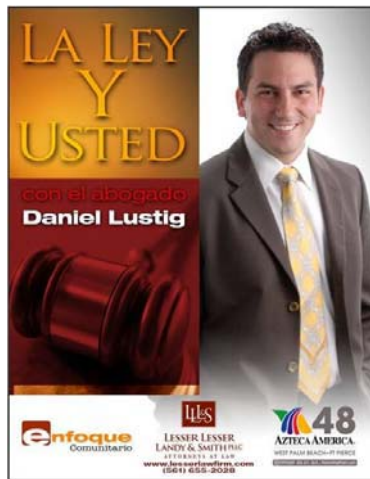
